International DesignBuild Summer School

In the urban coexistence conflict situations are the norm today. Different interests, objectives and values of individuals and social groups clash here. As architects we want to fight against a self-satisfied discipline that expresses itself as an exclusively affirmative concealment of conflict. Urban conflicts can be a spark for the development of the city through architecture. The crucial thing is to discover the possibilities that lie therein and the repertoire to use them. The prerequisite for this is an unbiased view that appreciates the latent poetry of the city. In the context of the international DesignBuild Summer School „Urban Conflicts“, we want to use productive urban dissonances and make them visible through architectural interventions in the field of tension between language and architecture at several locations in Hanover.

Students from three universities from different European contexts (Athens, Bratislava and Hanover) will each implement their own design in the urban space and work in international teams. In doing so, they will negotiate different interests through teamwork, a culture of discussion and a willingness to cooperate. In preparation for the Summer School, design basics will be taught in a digital workshop on the topic of „Text as a Design Instrument“. inputs from guests such as the architect Gabu Heindl from Vienna as well as supportive feedback from Assemble Studio (UK) on the projects to be realised will be included. The Summer School is part of YOU PROMISED ME A CITY, an international conference for experimental urban development organized by endboss, which will take place in Hanover on 10 and 11 June. The projects of the Summer School will be part of the international conference and exhibited there.
